

# Fruit of the Spirit (Part-05) - Kindness

(Luke 10:30-37)

## I. Fruit of the Spirit - Kindness

(a). Teacher illustratively *explains about the fruit of the Spirit to the children in interesting and attractive ways*

(b). Ask the children to mention the "nine types" of the fruit of the Spirit.

(c). The Fifth type of the fruit of the Spirit is KINDNESS. Titus 3:4-5 clearly states that our Lord Jesus saved us from death because of his love and KINDNESS. When you willingly wish to share something to make other people happy, it is a sign that you are practising the fifth fruit of the Spirit: KINDNESS!.



*Teacher's testimony about sharing their kindness to make people happy*

(d). Teachers tells the amazing story of the good Samaritan from Luk. 10:30-37 with the following details:

~ From where to where, the man in this story was robbed by the robber?

~ Mention the three persons who met this injured man after all he had being stripped off by the robber?

~ How these three person treated differently this injured man?

~ How the Samaritan man showed his kindness to this injured man?

~ Which person in this story that made the Lord impressed with his conduct?

(e). Lesson from the story of the good Samaritan:

(i). The man in the story was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, spiritually means that this man was leaving God's way and following the way of the world (Application: if you follow God's way, consequently you need to practice kindness to other people. Kindness is one of God's characters!

(ii). The robber in this story did not show any mercy to the man who was going down to Samaria. Why? Because he had never thought of practising and showing kindness to other people

(iii). Selfishness had caused the Priest and the Levite failed to share kindness with such injured man

(iv). The good Samaritan did not hesitate to share what he had to help the injured man. In other words, the good Samaritan had never doubted to pay the price in order to execute kindness into practice.

## II. How to get Kindness into practice?

(1). Be Selfless (Matthew 22:39)



*Teacher shares their testimony on living selfless life and what the impacts were to their life and others*

\* Teacher encourages the children to live selfless life

(i). Give hands to those who is needing help

(ii). Share things that you have with others

(iii). Practise this principle: Give and you will be given - Show mercy and you will receive mercy

(2). Let Your Kindness Be Known To Others Flp. 4:5

\* Ask the children to memorise Flp. 4:5

\* God's Name will be highly praised when you let your kindness be known to others

\* You can start to share your kindness with all the people who are close to you (parents, siblings, friends, etc)



*Teacher shares their testimony on showing their kindness to other people and what the results were*

## III. Class Creativity
