

Displaying The Excellency Of God (Part-02)

(Genesis 24:1-67)

I. Lesson From The Story of Rebekah watering Abraham's servant ten camels

(a). Teacher tells the story of Rebekah watering Abraham's servant ten camels in Genesis 24:1-67 in interesting way. Please do not forget to include the following details:

- ~ What was the purpose of Abraham sending his servant to his relatives' homeland? (verse 1-4)
- ~ How many camels went with Abraham's servant to his relatives' home land? (verse 10)
- ~ What was the name of Abraham's brother to whom his servant sent to? (verse 15)
- ~ Who was the girl who kindly attended Abraham's servant (verse 15)
- ~ What kind of favour that Rebekah had given to Abraham's servant and to his 10 camels? (verse 17-20)
- ~ What kind of things Rebekah received from Abraham's servant in return for her kind favour? (verse 22)
- ~ How could the servant knew that Rebekah was the one suitable for his master's son's wife? (verse 12-14)

(b). Lesson from the story of Rebekah watering Abraham's servant ten camels

(i). Every one of us has a call to display the excellency of God through our generosity (as what Rebekah did to Abraham's servant), because generosity is one of our God's excellent characters. When he gives, He always makes sure that He gives the best to us (Read: Romans 8:32 ..>> he event does not doubt to sacrifice His only beloved son to redeem our sin)

(ii). If you willingly share generosity with others, you will certainly receive generosity in return

(iii). Ask the children to read and memorise Matthew 5:7

(a). Ask the children what would they get for being generous to others? Proverbs 11:24-25
